


What You Need to Know

- Trips are one-way only to Mt. Holiday and Hickory Hills BATA assumes no liability for injuries or damages
- Get to the slopes quickly for only \$3.00 or \$1.50 for students (with valid student ID)
- Skis and snowboards are either safely stored in a specially designed ski bag located inside each bus or can be held by passengers
- BATA assumes no liability for injuries or damages incurred to equipment
- First come, first served (make sure that you arrive early)
- Passengers are responsible for loading skis or snowboards; drivers will assist

- Riding the bus means you don't have to worry about road conditions or gas prices. Just sit back, relax, and dream about that perfect powder
- BATA has formed partnerships with area schools to transport students to and from the slopes. No more long drives for parents. No parking headaches. Just a fun ride with friends and plenty of play time on the hills
- As part of the program, students can bring their gear to school and stow it in a designated area.
 They then retrieve their gear just prior to leaving for the resort. No extra driving to pick up gear.

- All gear is stowed safely and securely on the bus while you ride in complete comfort

Present your BATA Pass or receipt at the Crystal Mountain Lift Ticket Window and your round trip fee will be deducted from the ticket price. Season Pass holders and those purchasing lift tickets in advance will receive a food and beverage voucher, valid at any of Crystal Mountain's restaurants (cannot be used toward alcoholic beverages), equal to the cost of your round-trip fare.
