 TC Rail Study which is nearing completion.

The SDNT grant funded rail study, spearheaded by Groundwork Center, has been performed by Transportation Economics Management System ("TEMS") and is expected to be completed in July. A thorough analysis of potential ridership and operating structure was performed. The Rail Study is evaluating special event trains, 60mph trains, 90mph trains, and 110mph trains. A2TC.org has been created offering additional information.
